





OLD SAN JUAN

At night Old San Juan comes alive like few other places in Puerto Rico, shedding some of its daytime decorum to make way for an exciting blend of voices, live music, fine dining, and plenty of dancing. One of the primary entertainment areas, San Sebastian Street, is lined with nightclubs and quaint taverns where people of all ages gather to enjoy the lively nightlife scene. The Old City also attracts visitors who seek the peace and serenity of leisurely walks along the waterfront, down a cobbled street, or next to a historic monument. So prominent in daylight, the monuments attain a magical quality at sunset, the glory and splendor of the Spanish Colonial architecture enriched by comforting darkness and shadows. The experience transports first time visitors and residents alike to a place somewhere in the mists of 500 years of history.

FORT SAN CRISTOBAL

Fort San Cristóbal stands guard at where once was the eastern gate to the walled city of Old San Juan. Construction on the fort was begun in 1634 and finished in 1790, although modifications were made well into the 18th Century. Its better-known sister fort, El Morro, was designed to protect the city from attacks by sea; San Cristóbal guarded from approaches by land. Enjoy a walk on the ramparts, where half a millennium ago Spanish soldiers held their watch. A panoramic view of the coast from Old San Juan to Condado and beyond. The fort is open to the public daily from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm from June to November and 9:00 am to 6:00 pm December to May.

ELYUNQUE RAIN FOREST

The Caribbean National Forest called El Yunque Rainforest, is the most popular tourist attraction in Puerto Rico. When you see it, you'll easily understand why. Named after the benevolent Indian spirit Yuquiyu, El Yunque is the only rainforest in the U.S. National Forest System. Comprised of some 240 different species of trees, it is actually a series of forests, each one determined by its altitude. El Toro, the highest peak in the forest at 3,532 feet, has only odd dwarf vegetation clinging to its sides. More than 100 billion gallons of precipitation fall each year,



creating the jungle-like ambience of lush foliage, sparkling leaves, shining wet rocks, and shadowy paths occasionally pierced by sunlight. Spectacular waterfalls rush alongside its well-maintained (but slippery) trails. There are many favorite spots for visitors to take photos or a refreshing dip in the pristine pools. No one knows how many specimens of the noisy, ubiquitous tree frog, el coqui, live here, but you'll hear them. Naturalists have a better idea of the number (and location) of endangered Puerto Rican parrots, but they're not telling. You can see the forest best on foot, but much of its splendor can be appreciated during a slow drive up and down the mountain. You can explore on your own, park along a roadside tower to see the view, or take a guided tour. Please click here for detailed recreational activities available or call (787) 888-1880/1880 on weekdays. Be sure to take time for El Portal Rain Forest Center. It features interesting exhibits in English and Spanish, a well-stocked bookstore, and a souvenir shop. The Center's theater presents a documentary film every half-hour, and has several interactive exhibits, including one entitled "Understanding the Forest." There are also visitors' centers at Palo Colorado and Sierra Palm. You can Rent-a-Ranger by calling ahead for availability and rates at (787) 887-2875.

CAMUY CAVERNS


There are only two other places in the world where you will find a cave system as massive or dramatic as the Rio Camuy Cave Park – and neither of them has a tropical underground river thundering through it! Only a small part of the complex is open to the public: three crater-like sinkholes and two caves... but what a spectacular part it is! Visitors ride a trolley that descends into a sinkhole lined with dense tropical vegetation while a guide describes the sights. After a walk across ramps and bridges and through the dramatically illuminated, 170-foot high Cueva Clara, an-other tram shuttles you to a platform overlooking the 400 foot deep Tres Pueblos Sinkhole. Another attraction is the Spiral Sinkhole and Cave. You can walk the 205 steps down into the sinkhole, but the cave itself is off limits to all but experienced spelunkers. The sinkhole is believed to have once been an enormous cavern, and is indeed an impressive sight. Cathedral cave is home to an enigmatic collection of petroglyphs etched



into the walls by the ancient Tainos. The 268-acre grounds include a cafeteria, picnic area, gift shop, walking trails, exhibition hall, and theater. Advanced cave explorers can arrange for special tours and rappelling trips through undeveloped sections of the caves. The park is normally open Wednesday through Sunday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The last tour departs at 3:30 p.m., or when the park reaches its daily capacity. Call to confirm schedule and space availability (787) 898-3100.
